

# Movie Article Maker V2 Manual (11-23-2009 v1)

---



Movie Article Maker V2 is a program to monetize your MU Blog accounts made with Traffic X Suite or your own word press blogs by posting “movie review” articles to the blogs that direct viewers to a movie related affiliate offer. Usually the offer is a download/streaming movie offer found on many affiliate networks.

Movie Article Maker V2 major feature changes from version 1 is:

1. **Easier user interface**
2. **Post Directly to blogs.**
3. **Has most posting features of Traffic X Multiplier.** This includes backlinking, turning on XMLRPC, and deleting bad blogs, wait time between posting to all your blogs again, and

pause time between blog posts.

4. **Option to spin articles**
5. **A New, bigger, and cleaner Movie Database.**
6. **Instead of movie details, Movie Article Maker V2 articles make a movie review article.**
7. **Option to post movie reviews in the order they are in the movie database or post movie reviews randomly.**
8. **(Advanced Users) Ability to target and promote Amazon movies.** Please read the “Movie Article Maker V2 For Advanced Users” near the end of this manual.

## Using Movie Article Maker V2

When you first open up Movie Article Maker V2 you will be asked each time to verify your purchase information.

Please Note: Traffic X Suite clients use the same license information as you use for Traffic X Suite.

1 – Purchase Email – Enter your email you purchased with

2 – Reg Code – Enter your Reg Code that was emailed to you when you purchased.

When you have finished entering your license information press the “Verify” button. If your information is correct your license information will be saved so next time you open the program the license information will be automatically filled in for you.

## Movie Article Maker V2 User Interface

**1 – Blog Account File** – In this section you can load your blog account file from Traffic X Suite. The blog account is a text file with your blog account information in it. One blog per line. Traffic X Suite user’s mu blog account files, saved by Verifier is already in proper format.

You can also load your own word press blogs. Simply put your blogs you want to post movie articles to in a text file. One blog per line. You can add as many blogs accounts as you want to the blog account file. The blog account file must be properly formatted and should look like the example below.

**Yourblogusername:Yourblogpassword:yourblogdomain.com**  
**Yourblogusername2:Yourblogpassword2:yourblogdomain2.com**  
**Yourblogusername3:Yourblogpassword3:yourblogdomain3.com**

So for instance if I had 4 word press blogs of my own that I wanted to post movie articles and the information for each blogs is as follows:

chadmoviereview.com with username chaduser1 and password chadpass1.

mymoviereview.com with username chaduser2 and password chadpass2.

themoviereviews.com with username chaduser3 and password chadpass3.

wowmoviereviews.com with username chaduser4 and password chadpass4.

My blog account file would look like this:

chaduser1:chadpass1: chadmoviereview.com  
chaduser2:chadpass2: mymoviereview.com  
chaduser3:chadpass3: themoviereviews.com  
chaduser4:chadpass5: wowmoviereviews.com

Do not add the http:// or http://www at the beginning of your domain. Also do not at / at the end of your domains. Make sure that you have no spaces at the end of each line.

When you are ready to load your blog account file press the “!” button in the Blog Account File section to select you blog account file.

**2 – Your Affiliate Movie Link** – In this section you will input your link to your affiliate movie offer.

I have not tested for the most effective movie offer in this version yet but will be trying clickbank’s vendor: Stream Online Movies. You can make a link at clickbank for this movie offer by going to clickbank market place by [clicking here](#) and searching “movies” in the Keywords field. You may also find other movie offers searching there.

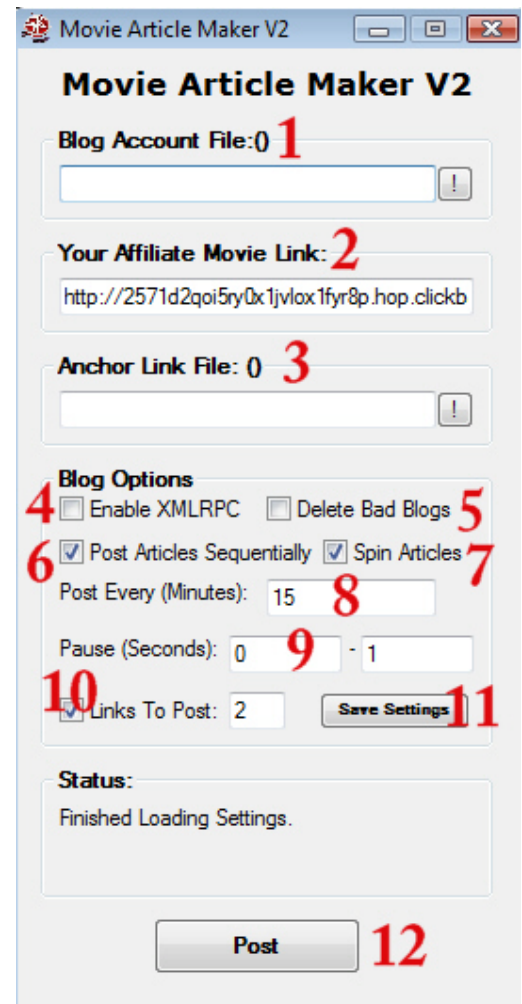

You can also search google for Movie Download Affiliate Programs, Movie Affiliate Programs, and Movie Affiliate Network for more movie download affiliate offers you can promote.

Please Note: Movie Article Maker V2 is capable of promoting movies at Amazon.com. Each movie posted will correspond to the Amazon page of that movie with your Amazon affiliate link. Making for very targeted promotions of Amazon movies. Please read “Movie Article Maker V2 For Advanced Users” at the end of the manual.



**3 – Anchor Link File** – In this section you can load your anchor link file to backlink to external links on the blogs you post to. This is anchor link file must be formatted and is exactly the same as the anchor link file you would load in Traffic X Multiplier. The anchor link file is a simple text file with one link/anchor text per line. The anchor link file format should look similar to the example below.

Of course you would put in your own link and anchor text on each line. The anchor links will be left on the bottom of your article post. The format is simply : your link, separated by CHADSEC: then your anchor link text (http://www.yourlink.comCHADSEC:Anchor Link Text).

In the example above the anchor links would be posted at the bottom of your movie article posted and look similar to this with each anchor text hyperlinked to the corresponding site :

[Watch Videos Online](http://www.youtube.com)  
[Official Twitter Site](http://www.twitter.com)

To post your anchor links you must enable it by checking the “Links To Post” section. In the “Links To Post” section you can also choose how many anchor links you want posted to each blog. Anchor links will not be posted if the “Links To Post” section is not enabled, even if your anchor link file is loaded.

## Blog Options

**4 – Enable XMLRPC** – In this section you can enable (checked) Movie Article Maker V2 to turn on XMLRPC on your blog so it can post articles. If XMLRPC posting is not turned on at your blog you will not be able to post movie articles. Most MU Accounts have XMLRPC turned off by default. I recommend enabling this option if you made new accounts with Traffic X Suite that have never been posted to before. Once XMLRPC is turned on at the blog you do not need to enable this option any longer unless you add new mu accounts that need XMLRPC turned on. If you do not see posts showing up at your blog accounts most likely XMLRPC is not turned on and you must turn it on by enabling this option.

**5 – Delete Bad Blogs** – This option will be used mostly by Traffic X Suite users. Enable this option (checked) to remove blogs from your blog account file that may not work anymore due to one of the following reason: Blog site does not exist anymore, blog Admin turned

off/banned your blog, and/or blog site is not working properly because of bad setup/configuration at mu blog host.

**6 – Post Articles Sequentially** – When this option is enabled (checked) Movie Article Maker V2 will post movies in the order they are in the database. If this option is unchecked it will post movies randomly. If this option is enabled, you can close Movie Article Maker V2 and next time you open it to post with this option enabled it will post the next movie where it left off.

**7 – Spin Articles** – If this option is enabled (checked) your movie article that is posted will be spinned. I strongly recommend using this option so your articles look unique.

**8 – Post Every (Minutes)** – In this section you can choose how many minutes to wait before Movie Article Maker V2 posts to all your blogs again. Movie Article Maker V2 will post to all your blogs in the blog account file, then wait how many minutes you choose in this section, and start posting movie articles to all your blogs again. The process is repeated over and over again.

**9 – Pause (Seconds)** – In this section you can choose how many seconds you want Movie Article Maker V2 to pause between posting to each blog. So for instance if I set this option to 5 and 10. Movie Article Maker V2 will post to a blog account, randomly pick a pause time between 5 to 10, pause that many seconds, then post to the next blog.

**10 – Links To Post** – When this option is enabled (checked) Movie Article Maker V2 will post anchor links from your anchor link file at the bottom of your movie review post. You can also choose how many anchor links you want to leave per blog post in this section. Please note that the program will randomly pick the anchor link to leave in your blog post.

**11 – Save Settings** – When you have configured all your settings press the “Save Settings” button to save your configuration so next time you close and open up Movie Article Maker V2 your settings will automatically be loaded.

**12 – Post** – When you are ready to post press the “Post” button and Movie Article Maker V2 will begin posting to your blogs.



# Tips On Using Movie Article Maker V2

---

I would like to leave some tips here on using Movie Article Maker V2 that may answer some of your questions on using Moving Article Maker V2.

1. The program should be left posting 24/7 for maximum benefits.
2. The program can be opened multiple times if you have many blog accounts to post to.
3. If running with Traffic X MU blog accounts, I suggest using 5K to 10K blog accounts per instance of the program you open. So say you have 20K blogs. I would split the blog account file in half. Then I would load one half in the first instance of Movie Article Maker V2 you opened and load the other half in the second instance you opened of Movie Article Maker V2 . There are many ways to split your blog account files. In a nutshell, with my example above of 20K blogs in the account file, open the account file in notepad. Highlight and copy half the accounts, paste in a new text file. Highlight and copy second half of blog accounts and paste in a new text file. Making 2 blog account files. I will release a free tool soon that will automatically split files.
4. As this version has not been tested yet for estimated times on how fast you will make money, here was typical results for the first version of Movie Article Maker. It took about 1-2 weeks to see sales come in on your affiliate offer. This was posting movie articles 24/7 with 10K or more blog accounts. It took about a month till orders came in consistently at \$50-\$100 a day, it took another week or two after that to see consistent orders of \$100 to \$200 a day. \*\*\*\*Remember, this was typical results on the first version and no guarantees on this version, this is just for your information. Also, take into account everything that made this work on the first version, this includes: Instructions were followed exactly, things like running the program 24/7, using the exact affiliate offer and only that offer (old version was THEMOVDOWNLOADS from clickbank), making sure your blog accounts file was cleaned every now and then and making sure you were always posting to 5K to 10K+ blogs, and many other factor that made it a success. Also note these results were typical when Movie Article Maker was first released and was not over used and movie articles were still ranking because articles weren't flagged as duplicate content (the new database, spinning options, and advanced user configuration should eliminate this). Most of all (and many of you first users , who had success, would agree), movie articles seemed to not convert after clickbank dropped all the P2P offers, including the one we had success with THEMOVDOWNLOADS. So, a very important factor in having success with this version is having an affiliate offer which converts!
5. There are many factors that will have to be taken into account to have success with this program. Some factors are:
  - 1 - What affiliate offer you use. You can get all the traffic you want but if the affiliate offer does

not convert, well, you won't make money.

2 – How long to post movie articles. You should be posting 24/7.

3 – Keep your blog accounts file clean. No sense in wasting time posting to blog accounts that do not work. Every week you should use the Delete Bad Blogs option, and add new blog accounts to the loop.

4 – Titles used for articles when posting. I have default titles that I think will work well with this program. These titles can be changed so you can test which titles may work best. Please read the "Movie Article Maker V2 For Advanced Users" section at the end of the manual to learn how to change your titles.

5 – How your content is arranged and looks when posting. I have made a default template for how your articles will look. This can be totally customized and optimized to test what will work best for you. Please read the "Movie Article Maker V2 For Advanced Users" section at the end of the manual to learn how to customize how your article looks.

6. Since there has been no testing on this version of Movie Article Maker V2 yet to tell you exactly what to do to get results I will be doing case studies on the SEO Munchies sites using Movie Article Maker V2 to test best affiliate offers to use, best settings, etc.,etc.,etc. I would also love to hear from anyone willing to share their results and methods that they use. I'm sure other users would love to hear it also! Post it on the comments or use the contact page to send your findings to me so I can share it to the SEO Munchies community. Even better, if you feel like you could really share something worth-while or in depth to the SEO Munchies community, write it, send it to me and I'll post the whole thing on the SEO Munchies site.
7. The HITS/CLICKS you see on your affiliate site may not be totally accurate. Previous users noticed that their clickback stats were crazy. Thousands and thousands of hits a day and wondered, wow, why did I not get any conversions? Don't worry, wordpress blogs ping every external link left on a blog post. =( Most tracking programs see this ping as a hit and it will show on the stats. I notice this with ClickBank and Amazon tracking, and there is absolutely nothing we can do about it unless you were the owner of the MU host.

In conclusion of this section, I would like say, this Movie Article Maker V2 still needs to be tested for optimal settings for money making results. In which I hope to get some settings that will perform well for you in my case studies I will be posting on SEO Munchies . Again, any testing results users would like to share please do!

I usually do not release programs unless I have had time to test the program to see if it will even make money, but this one has much hope, and I know many of you wanted a revamped version. So I'm hoping that everyone pitches in a little or a lot so we can use this program with optimal settings to make money.

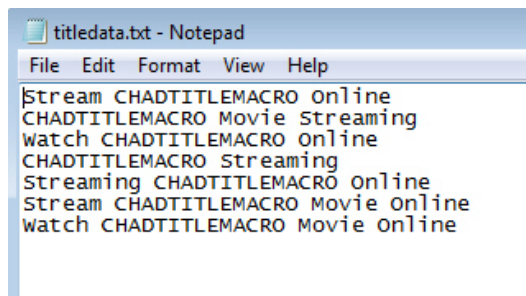
# Movie Article Maker V2 For Advanced Users

---

In Movie Article Maker V2 you can customize your titles and template for the articles you post. You can also promote Amazon DVDs and Blu-rays. When promoting Amazon each movie article will correspond to that movie at Amazon with your affiliate link.

## Customizing Your Movie Titles

Customizing your movie titles is very easy and is done by editing a text file called titledata.txt in Movie Articles V2 “includes” folder. This is usually located on your hard drive at:



Default titledata.txt File

C:\Movie Article Maker V2\includes\titledata.txt

Simply open up the titledata.txt file with your favorite text editing program. I usually use notepad. When opened you will see the default titles I added with the

program. You can edit this file to have as many titles as you want. One title per line. You can also use the

token/macro CHADTITLEMACRO in your titles add. When you put in the token CHADTITLEMACRO the program will replace it with the movie name/title when it posts the movie article. Movie Article Maker V2 also chooses a random title when posting. When you are done editing you can save the file. The title file must be named titledata.txt and be in the “includes” folder for it to work. If you think you made a mistake you can always open up the C:\Movie Article Maker V2\Examples\Default Titles.txt file. Copy and paste that into the titledata.txt file.

## Customizing the Article Template

You can also edit the way your article posts look by editing a text file in the “includes” folder called template.txt. This is usually located at C:\Movie Article Maker V2\includes\template.txt on your hard drive. I suggest you have a knowledge of HTML code if you are going to edit the template file and make your own. It can be edited without HTML code but can look very funny if not done right.

There are a few tokens/macros that you can use in the template.txt that will be replaced when Movie Article Maker V2 posts. These tokens are below:

CHADPRODUCTTITLE – If you use this token it will be replaced with the movie’s name. This is very useful and can be used like this: I really love the movie CHADPRODUCTTILE. I think CHADPRODUCTTITLE was one my favorite movies this year.

CHADAFFLINK – If you use this token it will be replaced with your affiliate link you input on “Your Affiliate Movie Link” section of the program. Here is an example of using this token:

CHADIMAGELINK – If you use this token it will be replaced with the image URL of the movie. This token is usually used with the code `` to display the image on your article.

CHADPRODUCTARTTITLE – If you use this token it will be replaced with the title of your article.

CHADARTICLECONTENT – If you use this token in the article it will be replaced with your movie’s review content. This token is usually a must when editing your template as this is where the bulk of your movie article content will be placed.

CHADAVGCUSTOMER – If you use this token it will be replaced with the “average rating stars” of the movie. The ratings come from amazon.com user ratings.

Here is an example of a simple edited template:

The following simple template change would post like this:



If you want to play around with editing the template and accidentally screw it up you can always open up the C:\Movie Article Maker V2\Examples\Default Template.txt and copy and paste it into the template.txt file.

Just like the titledata.txt file, the template file must be named template.txt and placed in your C:\Movie Article Maker V2\includes\ folder.

You can get pretty creative editing your own template, add image banners to other products, add tables, java script, etc.

If you are posting to MU blog accounts, most MU Hosts do not allow java script in the articles, so don't be surprised if

you include java script in your edited template and it won't show up on your MU blog account posts.

## Promoting Amazon Movie Products With Movie Article Maker V2

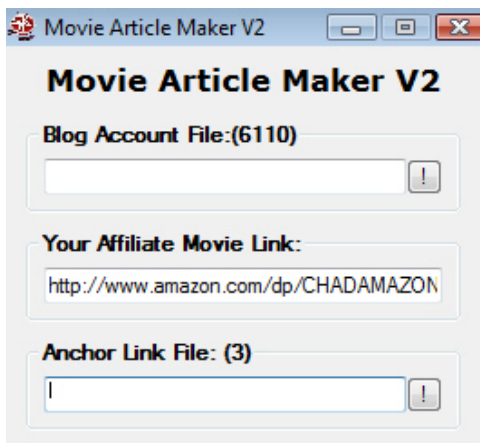
You can promote Amazon movie products (DVDs And Blu-Ray) with Movie Article Maker V2. When you promote Amazon, your affiliate offer will correspond with the movie on the Amazon site. For instance if the article posted is about Sleepless in Seattle, your affiliate links will go directly to the Sleepless in Seattle page on Amazon, where they can order from and you get credit. Also anything they order within 24 hours of going to Amazon from your link will be credited to you.

I strongly suggest that when promoting Amazon that you change your titles and template towards a "buy this movie on DVD" or "buy this movie" kind of theme instead of the default "download/stream movie" default theme/titles the program already has set.

For those of you who do not know how to edit the template, I've added an Amazon template you can use by opening up the file C:\Movie Article Maker V2\Examples\Amazon Template.txt. You simply copy the code in that file to the C:\Movie Article Maker V2\includes\template.txt file.

I also supplied an example of Amazon titles you may want to use as well. You can open the file C:\Movie Article Maker V2\Examples\Amazon Titles.txt. Copy the titles in there to C:\Movie Article Maker V2\includes\titledata.txt.

After you have changed your template/titles for Amazon promoting you there is one last setting to change on Movie Article Maker V2 settings.



You will want to edit your Affiliate Movie Link Settings with this:

<http://www.amazon.com/dp/CHADAMAZONASIN/tag?=REPLACEWITHYOURAMAZONID>

Be sure to change the REPLACEWITHYOURAMAZONID part with your Amazon ID, or you will get no credit.

When Movie Article Maker V2 posts it will replace the CHADAMAZONASIN with the movies ASIN number at Amazon. This way your links to Amazon will correspond to the movie at

Amazon, making a very targeted offer. So if someone finds your article about Harry Potter and The Half-Blood Prince, and clicks on your offer, it will go to the Harry Potter and The Half-Blood Prince page at Amazon, crediting you if they buy it.

Using the example Amazon titles/template that I included in the Example folder, your articles will look like this while promoting Amazon:
